I write in connection with your request for information received on 9th October. I note you seek access to the following information:

I am writing under the FOIA to request information directly relating to Palantir Nectar.

Please provide me with the following details, with data extracted from the first date of Palantir Nectar's operation (03/02/2025) until the date that this request is processed by Bedfordshire Police:

- 1. Details of serious incidents, bugs, personal data breaches or errors documented by Bedfordshire Police relating to Palantir Nectar. For each incident, include the following:**
 - a. Date of incident**
 - b. Nature of incident**
 - c. Nature of data involved**
 - d. Number of people affected**
 - e. Were affected people notified of the incident**
- 2. A copy of the initial response provided by the DPIA Advisor in relation to the Palantir Nectar DPIA dated 4/7/25**
- 3. A schedule list of Annex DPIAs related to the Palantir Nectar DPIA, which serves as the "master DPIA". Include the following:**
 - a. Document title**
 - b. Project Proposal Name**
 - c. Document publishing date**

- d. Date of which processing will commence**
- e. Copies of the DPIA where available**

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore, in the public domain without caveat.

Following enquiries within Bedfordshire Police Force please see our response below.

2. For the annex DPIA's within Nectar, they can be viewed in two parts:

a. Organisational

This annex DPIA is in relation to workforce data and can be segmented into four distinct use cases:

- 1) Workforce Planning - Seamlessly consolidate source systems into a single view, enabling people data to be visible and utilised for intelligent workforce decisions.
- 2) Resource Request - Automated resourcing of operations.
- 3) Vetting Applications - Automation of data collection and transactions in the vetting application process.
- 4) Postings - An intelligent and fully digitalised end to end postings process.

There are additional applications in platform, but they are all biproducts of the mentioned use cases. The use cases are all intrinsically linked which is why there is one annex DPIA. The intended audiences for this side are senior management, People & Workforce, Vetting and RMU.
